

GoChip Beam - Streaming Movies Anywhere

Foster City Library has received portable streaming movie devices called GoChip Beams! About the size and shape of a candy bar, these devices let you watch movies or TV shows on mobile device or computer without the need for an Internet connection or data. GoChip Beams are storage devices with their own Wi-Fi network that contain up to five feature-length movies or a full season of a TV series.
