### KANOPY - Stream Award-Winning Movies with Your Library Card

San Mateo County patrons now have access to more than 30,000 films for free through Kanopy! All you need is your library card to watch award-winning documentaries, rare and hard-to-find titles, cinema classics, and movies from around the world.

Kanopy offers a "Netflix-like" experience for streaming movies. You can watch Kanopy movies from any computer, television, or mobile device by downloading the Kanopy app for iOS, Android, Apple TV, Chromecast or Roku. You can stream 10 movies per month and can start watching immediately without any wait time. Like our other digital services, you won't accrue late fees for checking out titles as they will return automatically.

The collection includes videos from The Criterion Collection, Samuel Goldwyn, The Great Courses, PBS and thousands of independent filmmakers. Kanopy is consistently updating its collection so there are always new videos to explore.

The Foster City Library was honored to receive a sizable donation for technology and furniture updates in the children's room. Through his donation we now have a Laptop Anytime Kiosk, located in the children's room, with 30 new laptops available for checkout. 
