Library Bricks (\$150-\$200)

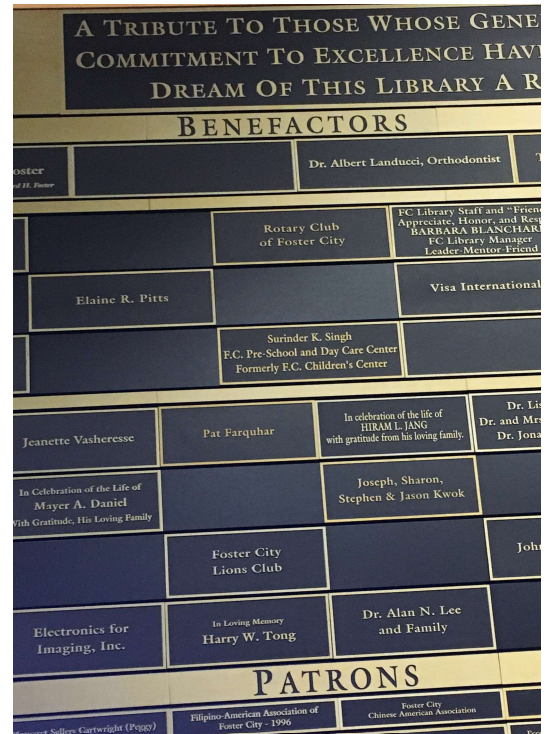
Along the pathway and pillars, bricks with inscriptions are engraved.

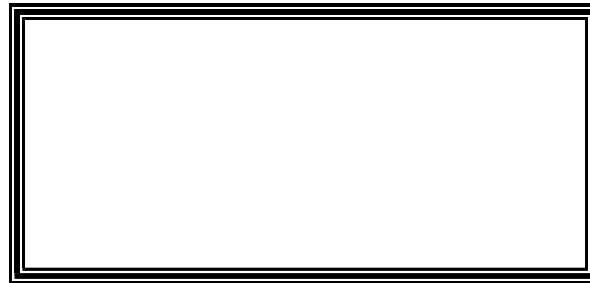
