


### Holiday Gift Idea: Bricks & Tiles!



# Meet D.M. Rowell, Author of Silent Are the Dead

In Never Name the Dead, Mae, a high-powered professional in Silicon Valley, had left the name "Mud" and her Kiowa roots behind a decade ago. After returning home to discover a tribe in disarray and her grandfather missing, Mud had to search for answers, plunging into a web of theft, betrayal, and murder. In Silent Are the Dead, Mud Sawpole is back on tribal land and uncovers an illegal fracking operation that threatens the Kiowa's ancestral homeland. When a local businessman involved in artifact thefts is murdered, and a respected tribe elder faces accusation of the crime, Mud searches deep within herself to find answers—and a murderer.

D. M. Rowell (Koyh Mi O Boy Dah), like her protagonist, Mud, comes from a long line of Kiowa (kai uh wuh) storytellers within a Plains Indian culture that treasures oral traditions.

### Teens Helping One Another and Their Community!



The Youth Committee's official year began July 1 and in August saw one of their most successful activities for Foster City teens since the committee formed in 2021: tote bag painting. Under the leadership of co-chairs Katie and Sivan, the committee has made plans for a variety of activities for the coming year: a repeat of last year's Hallow-teen afternoon that will have teens decorating jars with an alternative activity of tote bag painting and origami. Some other events in the works: a holiday card making day, an investment presentation by a Foster City high school student in conjunction with the library's staff, another book swap in the spring, henna painting in the spring, as well as more arts and crafts projects.

The Foster City Library Youth Committee brings together Foster City teens who attend local and nearby middle and high schools. Together, they come up with creative ideas to connect youth with one another

and foster a sense of community. Committee members also help the Friends of the Foster City Library with their events and fundraising efforts such as the Book Shop sale. Last fall's toy drive successfully collected a significant number of new toys that were distributed by the Foster City fire department, and their summer Life Moves drive to collect clothing and toiletries raised carloads of donations and helped local people transitioning from homelessness to shelters and apartments. Through their work and in collaboration with the library staff, this enthusiastic group of teens is making a positive impact on Foster City!

- Dec 1, 2024 Jan 11, 2025 Accepting bookmark submissions in-person at the library or online at <a href="https://bit.ly/25fcbookmark">https://bit.ly/25fcbookmark</a> or by scanning the QR code.
- Jan 11, 2025, 5:00 PM PT Bookmark design submissions due. Entries received after 5:00 pm are not eligible.
- Jan 21-31, 2025 Jurying by contest panel and age group winners notified via email.
- Mar 22, 2025, 10:15 AM Winner presentation ceremony at the library.

### **Bookmark Design Contest Rules**

- 1. Contestants must live, work, or attend school in Foster City.
- 2. Each age group category will have one winner who will be notified via email. Categories are Preschool Kindergarten Grades 1-2 Grades 3-4 Grades 5-6 Grades 7-8 Grades 9-12 Adult (18+).
- 3. Limit one entry per submitter.
- 4. Bookmark design must be original work. Nothing previously published will be accepted. Popular figures (ex. Marvel, Disney, etc.) cannot be considered due to copyright restrictions.
- 5. Books, libraries and/or reading should be included in the design.
- 6. Bookmarks may be created in color or black-and-white. Acceptable media includes flat 2-dimensional graphics and collage on paper or paperboard • Colored pencil • Marker • Crayon • Gouache • Tempera • Oil • Acrylic • Fingerpaint • Chalk • Watercolor • Pen-and-ink.
  - a. No photography or digital imagery.
  - b. Glitter and reflectives do not reproduce well and are discouraged.
- 7. Entries are valid only when accompanied by this completed and signed registration form.
  - a. All contact information on the registration form must be clear and legible. Please include a personal email that is actively monitored as we will notify winners via email. If a winning participant does not respond within 7 days to our communication, their win will be voided and the judging panel will select another winner.
- 8. Completed entry forms may be returned in-person at the Foster City library or online at <a href="https://bit.ly/25fcbookmark">https://bit.ly/25fcbookmark</a>. Completed entry forms may be returned until 5:00 pm PT on January 11, 2025.
- 9. Bookmark designs will be accepted December 1, 2024 January 11, 2025. Entries will not be returned after judging.
- 10. Parents or guardians of entrants under 16 years old must sign the completed form.
- 11. Judging panel will include Friends of the Foster City Library board members and Library staff. Submissions will be judged on originality, theme and creativity. The panel's decisions are final.
- 12. Winning entries will be printed and available at the Foster City library.
